The purpose of the event was to

1. Create a networking session in an informal environment for young engineers
2. Learn more about the brewing process and products

NOTES

- An email was sent out two and a half weeks before the event and then one reminder email a week before the tour to the IPENZ Canterbury engenerate emailing list.
- People were asked to email Sam P for tickets, and then he sent them to their nearest committee member to pick them up. Some people paid on the day if this didn't suit.
- We had 34 people attend, with 15 different engineering firms represented. One person missed the bus because he was half an hour late, and two pulled out on the day).
- A bus was provided from Cathedral Square to the brewery, with people asked to gather at 5.15pm, and the bus leaving at 5.30pm. The bus was a little late because it had been waiting in the wrong place although this wasn't a problem for the tour. Some people met us at the brewery instead, particularly if they didn't work in the city centre.
- The tour was taken by Carl Harrington who is a brewer, and a staff member who works in the bottling section of the brewery. The group was split into two to do the tour.
- Nibbles, a selection of beers and non-alcoholic drinks were provided prior to the tour, with savouries and a tasting after the tour. It seemed that everyone had a great time including the staff, as we have been invited back.
