We will confirm your Membership and send you a Graduation Membership certificate.

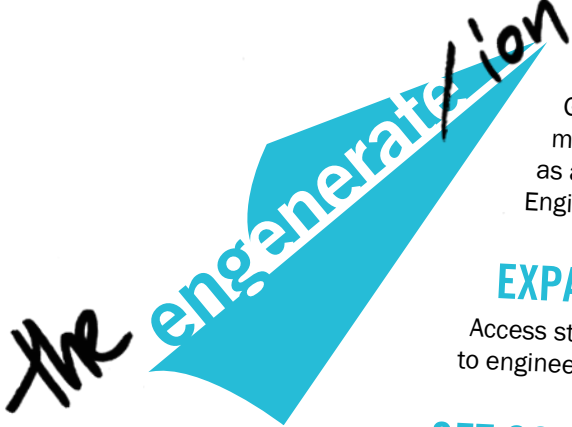
