2. Supporting Statement to be attached by the nominator (approximately 250–500 words in total) addressing the criteria for the Award entered.

### Supreme Technical Awards for Engineering Achievers

Technical expertise in engineering as exemplified by contributions to advancement of engineering practice, innovation or technical breakthroughs. Evidence may include:

- technical papers advancing knowledge
- recognition by others (nationally or internationally) as leaders in their area of practice
- track record of creating new solutions to engineering problems
- major improvements in engineering practice through codification or standard development
- ingenious new artefacts, products, systems or services with enhanced properties.

### Turner Award for Professional Commitment

Demonstrated commitment to the ideals of a self-regulating profession as judged by some of the following:

- actively upholding and promoting the ideals of a profession
- contributing to the processes of self-regulation – voluntary activities on committees, taskforces, panels etc
- willingly disseminating technical information to colleagues, as well as the wider community
- promoting engineering as a career to young people and/or mentoring of young engineers
- consistently demonstrating and upholding the Institution's Code of Ethics
- actively involved in community affairs
- ongoing commitment to upskilling and maintaining their own knowledge and professional skills.

3. Nominee's curriculum vitae.
4. Referee letters in support of the nomination.
5. Any other supporting documents you wish to be included in the submission.
6. Head and shoulder photo of the nominee for publication reasons. Photos need to be supplied electronically (on CD or emailed to [awards@ipenz.org.nz](mailto:awards@ipenz.org.nz)). Photos should be 300dpi or of high quality for printing purposes.

- b) IPENZ reserves the right to arrange nominations.
- c) Judges will be given the discretion not to make an Award if required standards are not reached or criteria are not met.
- d) The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- e) All applications for the IPENZ Supreme Awards for Engineering Achievers must be received by **5.00pm 31 October 2010**

### Judging for Supreme Technical Award for Engineering Achievers

- a) The judging panel shall comprise five people, four of whom are technical experts covering the disciplines concerned plus a nominee from the sponsor. The panel works by consensus.
- b) In the case of the John Cranko Award, the supreme technical award for engineering achievers in the Category "mechanical and manufacturing", where it is reasonably possible a member of the family of John Cranko will be invited to participate in the judging of the award.
- c) Particular emphasis will be given to innovation and its application. Preference will be given to candidates whose contribution has been recent, and who are actively involved in and demonstrating technical leadership in advancing engineering practice.

### Judging of Turner Award for Professional Commitment

- a) The judging panel shall comprise four people, where possible one of the panel will be an IPENZ Board member. The panel works by consensus.
